- 6. What happened after the Tabernacle was finished? (v.34-38)

### **Application:**

- 1. Why do you think all the preparations of the Tabernacle were so important before God's glory would descend up on it?
- 2. Knowing that we are "Tabernacles of the Lord" since the Holy Spirit lives in us? What do we need to do to prepare ourselves for God's presence? How is this a one-time event? How is this an ongoing practice?
