

Questions for Discussion

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Read 4:1-4 on Jesus being tempted in the Wilderness. According to Luke 4:1, why did Jesus go into the wilderness? What compelled him?
- 2. According to Luke 3:21-23, what happened immediately before Jesus went? What is revealed about Jesus? Why might this context be important for framing what happens to Jesus in the wilderness?
- 3. What happened to Jesus for forty days? What was on his agenda and what do you think he was trying to accomplish? (v.2a) Why do you think the devil wanted to tempt Jesus? What was on his agenda and how does this compare to those of Jesus?
- 4. What spiritual practice was Jesus performing and what were the physical results on him? (v.2b) How did the devil tempt Jesus in verse 3, and what did he try to use to make his appeal?
- 5. How did Jesus respond? How does this scripture verse shed light on Jesus' whole experience in the wilderness? (see Luke 4:4 and Deuteronomy 8:2-3)
- 6. In what ways are you tempted to disregard God's commands and obey other voices in the world instead? How are you tempted to depend on your provision from things of this world rather than from God?
- 7. How might God be testing your heart this Lenten Season? In what ways have you been unfaithful to God's commands? Which ones? What difference does Jesus' faithfulness make when you become aware of sin in your life?
