Read Luke 22:1-3

Digging Deeper:

1. Looking at verses 1-6, identify all the groups and individuals who were conspiring against Jesus.
2. Why do you think Judas was willing to betray Jesus? What factors went into his decision according to this passage?
3. Who did Jesus entrust the Passover preparations to? What were his instructions to them? How was Jesus being secretive about where they were going to have Passover, and why?
4. What did the Passover meal signify? Why were Jews commanded to celebrate this feast annually? What role did the sacrificial lamb have in the first Passover?
5. What is the significance of Jesus initiating a new commemorative meal for his disciples on Passover? What were his followers encouraged to remember from now on?
6. What was the "new covenant" poured out in Jesus' blood? What was the old covenant? Why is the new covenant better?
7. If Jesus knew who was going to betray him, why didn't he stop him?

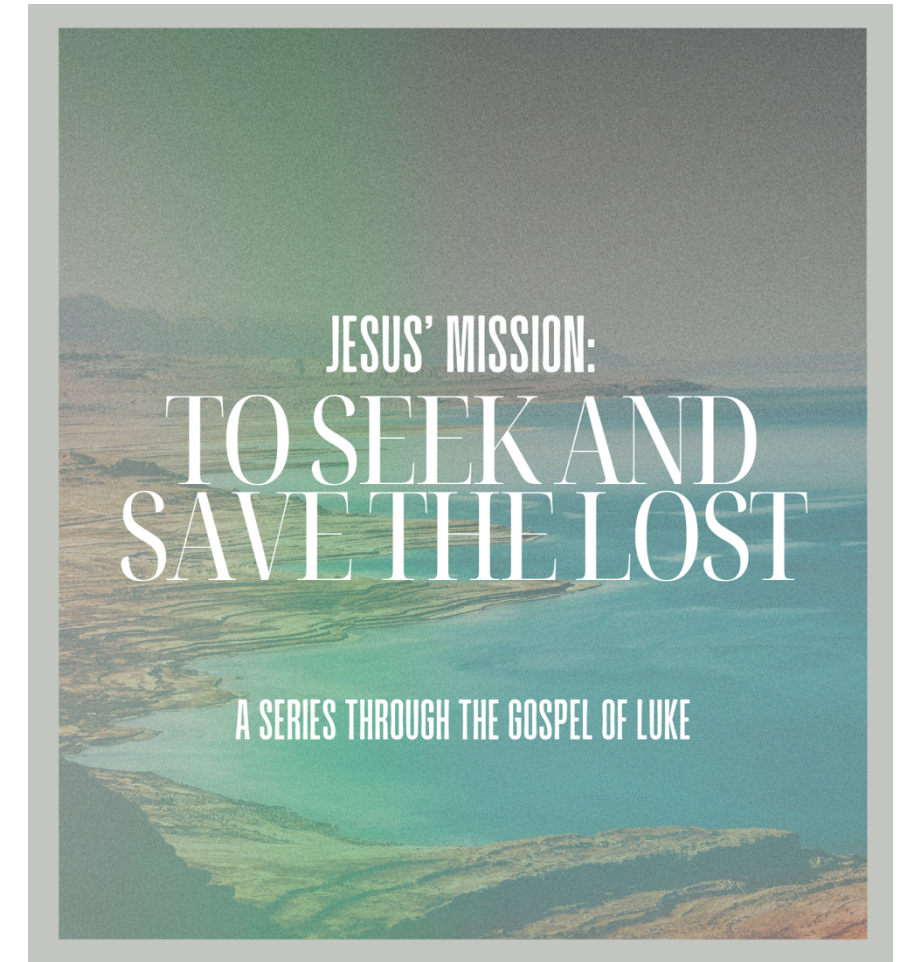
