2. Where does true righteousness come from? (v.9) Why do people try to earn God's favor through acts of righteousness? Are acts of righteousness a bad thing?

3. What is Paul's greatest passion in life? (v.10-11)

4. What does Paul compare a life in Christ to in verses 11-14? What is his goal and prize?

Application for Life:

1. What gets in the way of your passion for making Christ your greatest passion and highest priority in life?

2. What things in life can threaten a person from persevering in the faith?

3. What would it mean for you to have the power of the resurrection at work in your own life?
