Questions for Discussion

Read: Genesis 6:13-22

1. Why did God want to destroy all people? (v.13, 17)
2. What did he tell Noah to do? (v.14-17)
3. Why did God want to spare Noah and his family? (v.18-21)
4. In a way, Noah was like a new Adam, but how was he different from Adam? (v.22)

Read Genesis 8:20-22

1. After the flood was over and Noah reached dry ground – what did he do 1st? (v.20)
2. How did God receive the offering? What promise did God make? (v.21)
3. What hymn uses the lyrics from verse 22; what aspect of God's character does this verse lift up?

Read Genesis 9:8-17

1. Who did God make a covenant with after the flood? (v.8-10, 12) Why is this significant?
2. What was God's promise in verse 11? What does this say about God's character and heart?
3. What was God's sign to remember his covenant with Noah and all creation? (v13-16)
4. What do you think this covenant symbolizes about God and his relationship to mankind?


