The Moment When Life Turned into a Nightmare

Opening Discussion:

- Was there ever a time in your life or someone close to you when life became more difficult than you ever imagined? Share what that experience was like.

Digging Deeper:

- Read Genesis 37:12-36. How had Joseph's life turned into a nightmare?
- What were the brother's feelings toward Joseph? Do you think they were they justified in their feelings? (Read also Genesis 37:1-11.)
- What did Joseph's brothers want to do with him initially, why did they change their mind? What did they do instead?
- How would the brothers' relationship with Joseph affect their relationship with their father Jacob (Israel)?
- Many years later, Joseph reflected on his brother's actions. What did he say to them in Genesis 50:19-21? What enabled him to say that? (See also Genesis 39:2a.)

Life Application

- When bad things happen to you, what feelings does it stir up in your own heart?
- In your life, how do your circumstances affect your faith and relationship with God?
- In what ways can you cultivate your relationship with God, so that when difficulties rise you will turn toward God and not away from him?
- Are there any areas in your life right now where you feel distant from God or are without hope? What other believers in your life can you reach out to for support?

Suggestions for Prayer

- Praise God for being the "God who sees" and the "God who hears;" for being present in all places and times, including in your life's circumstances.
- Lift up your difficulties and challenges in life to God, entrusting them to his power, wisdom, love and goodness.
- Pray that God would reveal himself to you in the midst of your struggles, saying "Show me what you want me to know about this situation," or "Show me what you want me to do."
- Remember and practice Philippians 4:6: "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God." ... so that you might experience Philippians 4:7: "And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."
