# Questions for Reflection

## Simon Peter: Come Fishing with Me

### Opening Discussion:

- Have you ever had your day interrupted to assist an important person in some way? Who was it and what were you asked to do?

### Digging Deeper:

- In this passage Simon responds to Jesus in four different ways. Read Luke 5:1-11.
- What is the first thing Jesus asks of Simon and why was this helpful to Jesus? (See verses 1-3) What was Simon doing when Jesus approached him and what part of his workday was this? How would you have responded if you were in a similar situation? How did Simon respond, and why? (v. 3)
- After he finished teaching, what else did Jesus ask Simon? Why do you think Jesus asks this? How does Simon respond and what does he call Jesus? (See verses 4-5.) What does this reveal about Simon?
- In verse 7, what did Simon do in response to the big catch, who does he reach out to?
- What did the big catch reveal about Jesus and how did Simon react to Jesus afterward? Why do think he responded in this way? (See v. 8) Why were Simon and his partners astonished?
- What is the last thing Jesus said to Simon? What does Simon do? Who else responded this way? Why do you think they were willing to do this?

### Life Application:

- Was there a time in your life when you felt the Lord asking you to do something that was inconvenient or didn't make sense?

### Suggestions for Prayer:

- Pray for Jesus to expand your view of who he is in your life.
- Pray for wisdom and discernment about how to follow Jesus with your whole life.
- Pray for those who don't know Jesus and that God would put them in your life each day that you might reach out to them.
