# **Reflection Questions**

## **Connecting with One Another**

• In your observation, what are the traps in life that get in the way of living the abundant life in Christ?

## **Listening and Acting upon the Text**

Read James 1: 9-18

**Background:** James is the head of the church in Jerusalem, and he is writing this letter to the scattered Christians who are facing hardship, suffering, illness, and persecution for their beliefs. They are looking for some wisdom and seeking advice from a trusted leader in their lives.

- What are the poor and the rich invited to celebrate? (vs. 1) What do they have in common and how might this be godly wisdom?
- To what degree does your confidence in wealth connect with your confidence in life?
- Read Isaiah 40:6. What does it tell us to focus upon in life? What is your favorite verse and why?
- What is the relationship with getting wealthy and temptation?
- Where does temptation come from and what is the potential outcome of temptation?
- If the reward for enduring temptation is the crown of life, what have you discovered helps to endure temptation and avoid it?
- Why do some people say, "The Devil made me do it?" and what does scripture say about this in vs. 14-15?
- What are the implications of having a God "whom there is not variation or shadow due to change" and the relationship with temptation?

**Talking with God:** Read the lyrics from this song and offer them up to God in prayer. Begin with saying:

O God...

I love You Lord; Oh Your mercy never fails me All my days; I've been held in Your hands From the moment that I wake up; Until I lay my head I will sing of the goodness of God

Chorus: All my life You have been faithful
