# Reflection Questions

## Connecting with One Another:

When you think about this sermon series on James, what is something that has challenge or comforted you?

## Listening and Acting upon the Text:

Read James 5:12-19

## Background:

James is the head of the church in Jerusalem and writing this letter to the scattered Christians who are facing hardship, suffering illness, and enduring persecution for their belief in Jesus Christ. He is providing them guidance and wisdom to endure in the faith and ultimately mature as disciples of Jesus Christ. In this section of chapter 5, James is pointing us to a way in which we can be patient in life and eventually live from a mature trust in Jesus Christ.

## Questions of the Text:

1. Why is it so important that we are clear with our answers in life? Why is this so difficult?
2. James identifies several situations (vs. 13-14) from which people find themselves in life. Identify them and what does James tell them is the answer? What, if any, are the connections between the answers?
3. When was a time when you received the benefit of prayer?
4. What are some concrete ways in which you can pray for others through social media?
5. When you see someone doing something wrong, how do you typically respond and why?
6. What is significant for James about bringing someone back from “wandering”? When for you, was a time when someone reached out and brought you home to the faith? Share the story if you are comfortable and reflect on the significance?
7. Read James 1:2-4 and reflect on how you have matured in the faith through this series? In other words, where have you made some traction as a disciple of Jesus?

## Talking with God:

- Spend some time praising and thanking God for his love and care for your life.
- Confess your need for God to forgive you and ask for God to give you the strength to forgive those who have hurt you as well.
- Lift in prayer those people whom God loves and wants to return to the faith. Ask God for courage to reach out to them and give you the words to say for their return.
- Spend a few minutes resting in the grace and mercy of God, seeking healing for your soul and forgiveness for what you have done wrong in life.
- Ask God to reveal what you need to put into practice through this series.
