Reflection Questions

Pressing On - Partners in Joy

Philippians 2:12-18

Summary: The world continues to try and provide an alternative to the life that the Holy Spirit gives us. It is easy to “murmur and argue,” as Paul says, but we are empowered to live a life worthy of the Gospel when we let the same mind be in us that was in Christ Jesus. The Philippian church can be like stars in the world, and by the grace of God, so will we in a world that points in other directions for answers.

Connecting:

1. Share what was meaningful to you from the message this week.
2. Who are the people in your life that are most happy? Between 1-10, how happy would people describe you?

Listening and Acting in Faith:

1. As a Christian, what is easy for you to do in life?
2. What does it mean to work out our salvation with fear and trembling? (vs. 12)
3. What are some topics that you notice people complaining about in the world?
4. What is Paul trying to convey to us when he says, “**14** *Do everything without grumbling or arguing, 15 so that you may become blameless and pure, “children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation.”*
5. When you think about Christ's return, to what degree does this give you hope?

Listening and Acting:

1. What is one way that the Holy Spirit asks you to shine like a star in the world today?
2. Bonus: If you are in a group, take a moment to point out a way in which someone else in the group shines like a star in the world today.
