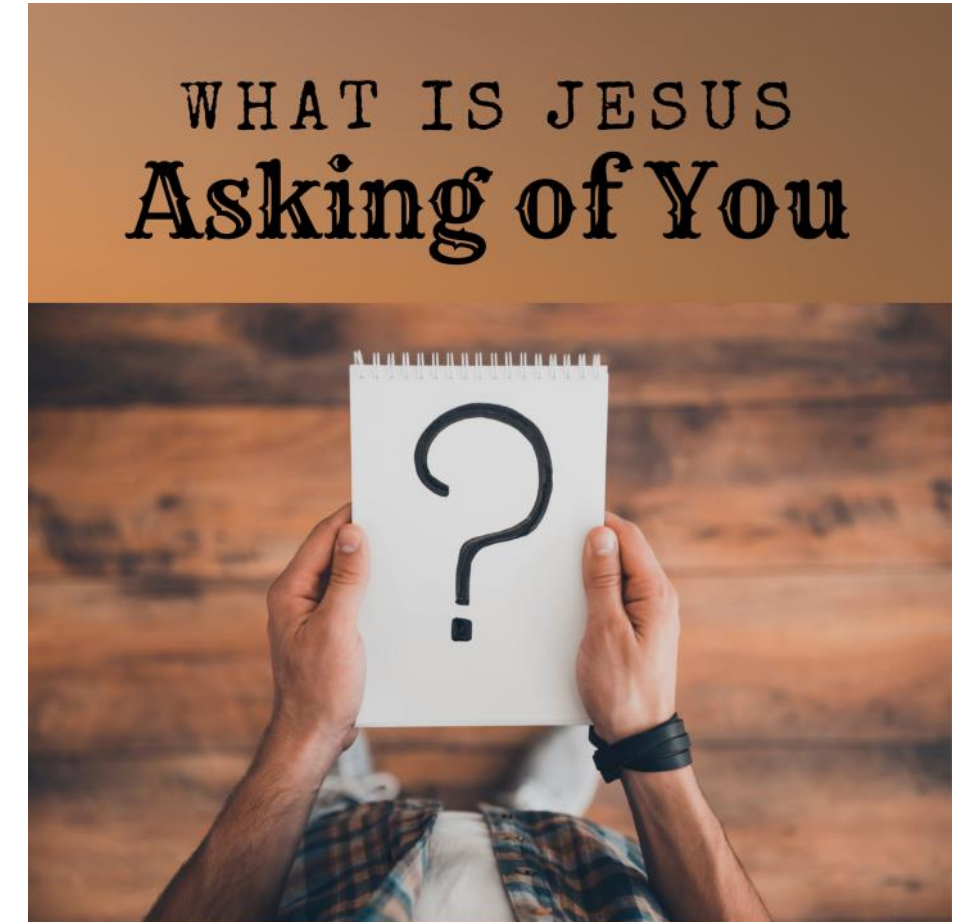
9. When you consider where you spend your time in life, what does it reveal to you?
