### Connecting:

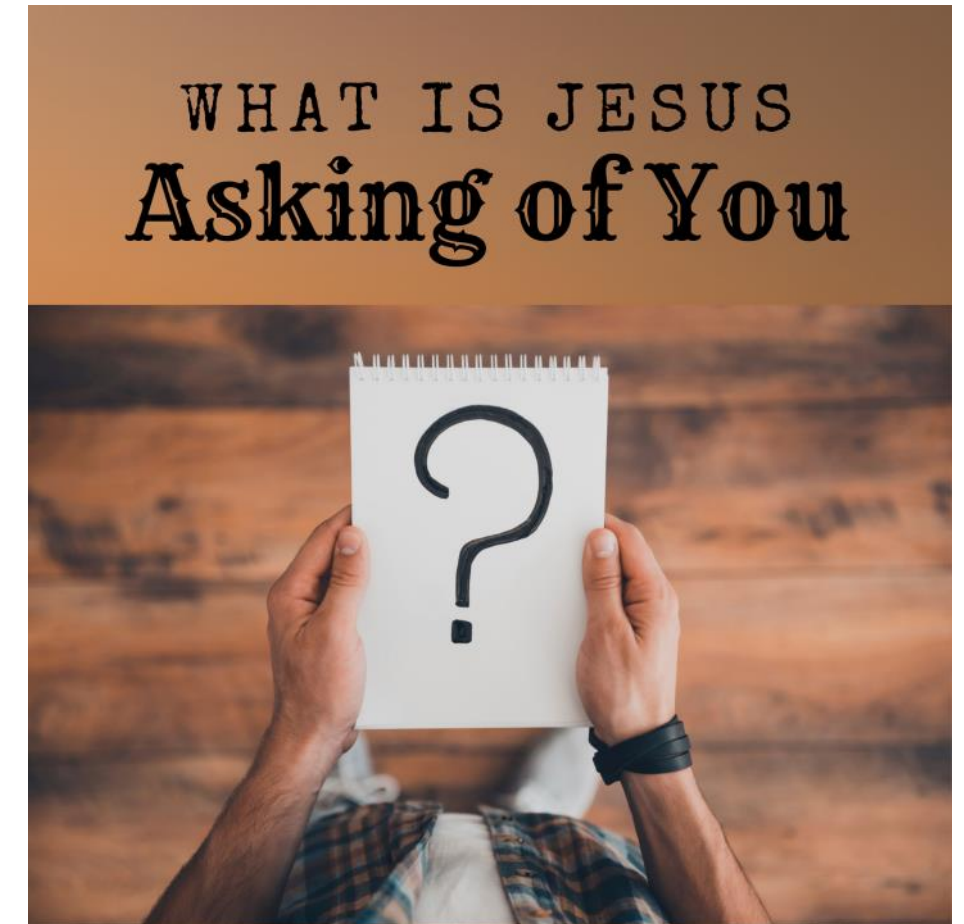
1. Write or share what was meaningful to you about this week's message.
