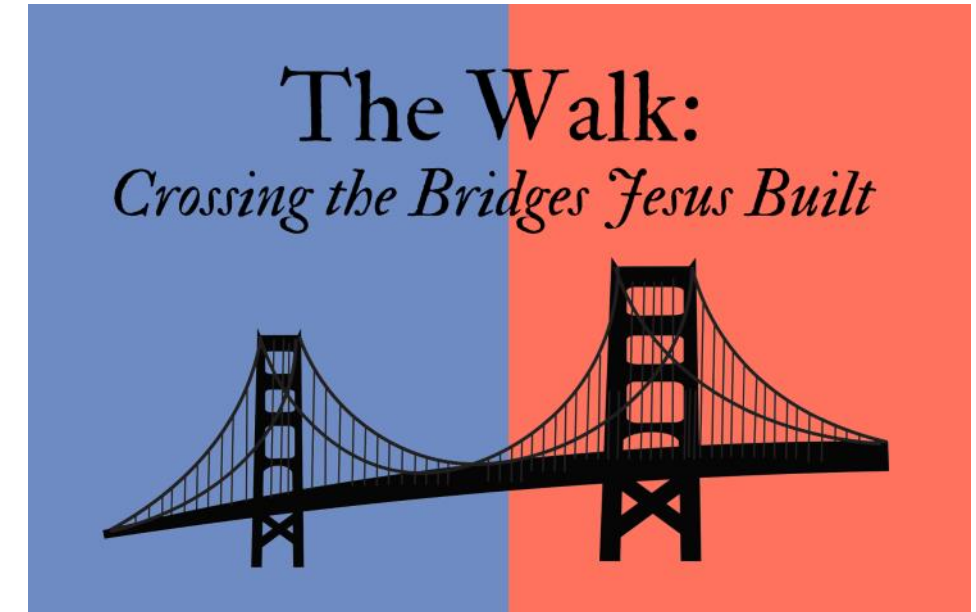

## *The Walk: Crossing the Bridges Jesus Built* Jesus and the Bridge to Salvation Luke 19:1-10

1. How would you describe repentance? How is repentance similar and different from confession or apologies?
2. How is Zacchaeus portrayed in verses 2-4?
3. How was Jesus' treatment of Zacchaeus different from the people in the crowd? Why do Jesus and crowds respond to Zacchaeus so differently? (see vs. 5 & 7)
4. What was Zacchaeus' response to Jesus? (see vs. 6 & 8) What made him do this?
5. How does Jesus lift up Zacchaeus in v. 9 and why does he say this?
6. What did Jesus mean when he said, "For the Son of Man came to seek and save the lost" in v. 10?
7. Share examples you've witnessed of people radically changing their lives in light of Jesus.
8. Who are the lost in your culture? In your community? Among your friends and family? How does the way Jesus reached out to Zacchaeus model for us how to reach out to others?
8. How might you reach out and welcome someone from another culture? Is there a person or people group that God has put on your heart?
9. Pray for the Spirit to guide you and move you to reach out to other cultures other than your own, right here on the Northshore.
