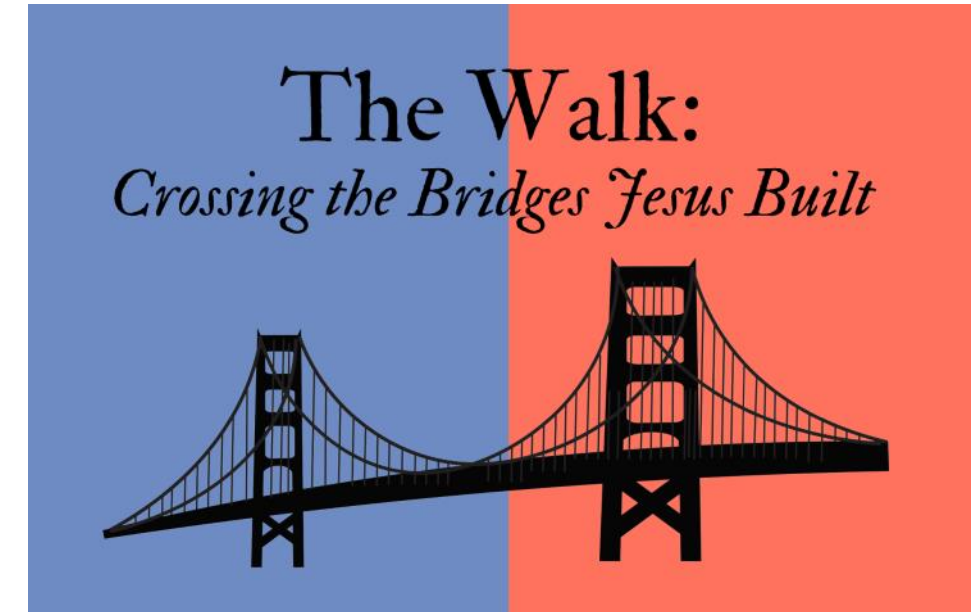

Blessing

The Walk: Crossing the Bridges Jesus Built **Jesus and the Bridge to Service**

Read John 13:1-17

1. Read John 13:1 only. What is the setting for this passage? What does it mean "to love them to the end"? How does this frame what is about to happen in the passage?
2. Now, read John 13:1-17. Why do you think John included the section about Judas?
3. Why was Peter surprised and uncomfortable that Jesus was washing the disciples' feet? What was Jesus' response? What do you think he meant by this? (see v. 7)
4. What was going to happen to Jesus the next day (Good Friday)? How might foot washing be a symbol of what is to come? How does this shed light on Jesus' conversation with Peter about being clean? Who wasn't clean in Jesus' eyes?
5. What does Jesus say to the disciples in the closing verse? Why does he want them to imitate him? What is at the root of this command? How is this command shaped by love?
6. Where does Jesus promise blessing for the disciples?
7. Why is sacrificial service such an effective way of showing love toward others?
8. What are ways people today can "wash the feet of others"?
9. Who are people you need to serve in this way?
