Jesus Healing the Ten Men with Leprosy - Luke 17:11-19

- 2. What do you think the 10 lepers wanted Jesus to do for them?
- 3. How did Jesus respond and heal them? Why did they have to go to the priest? (See Leviticus 14:1–8)
- 4. What does this passage say the 10 lepers did in response to their healing? What three things did the one who turned back do?
- 5. Verse 16b says that the man who came back to Jesus was a Samaritan. Why is this significant? See Jesus' response in verses 17 and 18.
- 6. What were Jesus' final words to the Samaritan? What might indicate that he was speaking of something more than just physical healing?
- 7. Commit to regularly turning to Christ to share your gratitude for the blessings in your life and the impact the Savior has made on you personally.
