Opening Discussion:

Describe a time in your life when you knew that your situation was about to change significantly and you were feeling apprehensive about the future.

Read: John 14:25-27

"I have said these things to you while I am still with you. But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you everything, and remind you of all that I have said to you. Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid."

Digging Deeper:

- 1. Skim over chapters 13 and 14 of the Gospel of John which begins Jesus' discourse in the Upper Room. Why would the disciples feel apprehensive about the future? Do you think they fully understood what was about to happen to Jesus?
- 2. Jesus was leaving soon, but who was God sending in his place? What was its purpose in being sent to the disciples?
- 3. Looking at verse 27, what is peace an antidote for? Where does it come from? How is the peace that Jesus gives different from peace that the world offers?

Application for Life

- 1. Was there been a time in your life when the Lord through the Holy Spirit gave you peace? What were the surrounding circumstances?
- 2. What are some areas in your life where you need peace right now?
- 3. What are the challenges to receiving Christ's peace? In past experiences, what has gotten in the way of feeling that peace in your own life?
